1 16 oz. round loaf sweetbread 1 21 oz. can Comstock apple pie filling 1/2 cup raisins 2 cups milk 1/2 cup butter (1 block) 3/4 cup sugar 5 eggs, beaten cinnamon, for sprinkling

Break sweetbread in pieces and place into 9x13 inch pan. Spread apple pie filling over bread. Then sprinkle raisins over. Scald milk; add butter and sugar and stir until melted. Cool milk mixture; mix in beaten eggs and pour over bread. Sprinkle with cinnamon. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes.

Yield: about 20 servings

The membership of Honolulu Orchid Society Incorporated voted to approve the following change to the Bylaws of the Corporation at the Regular Meeting held on September 13, 2017 at Lanakila Elementary Axhool XDWRWEI, 717 N. Kuakini St., Honolulu, HI 96817:

RESOLVED, that Article IV, Section 3 of the Bylaws of the Corporation is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. Quorum. Thirty (30) members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
