

4 pieces pork chop 1 cn (10 1/2 oz) cream of mushroom soup 1/2 cup sour cream 1/4 cup water 2 tbsp chopped parsley 4 cups potato, thinly sliced1/4 water salt and pepper to taste

Brown pork chops. Blend sour cream, water, soup and parsley. In a 2 quart casserole alternate layers of potatoes sprinkled with salt, pepper and sauce. Top with pork chops. Cover with foil and bake at 375 degrees. 1 hour and 15 minutes.

(Note: I sprinkle the pork chops lightly or to taste with garlic powder and pepper prior to browning for added flavor to the pork chop.)

Natural height of plant from the base to the top of the plant (excluding flowers above the leaves) must not exceed 7 inches and the natural width of the leaf span must not exceed 7 inches. Exhibitors must specify at time of registration the plant is to be entered in the miniature display.
