Won bok cabbage, sliced Iceberg lettuce, sliced Green onions, sliced thin

Dressing:

1 c. salad oil

1/4 c. mayonnaise

1/2 c. sugar

1/2 c. Japanese rice vinegar

Tomato, sliced

Crispy Wonton Pi, crushed

Sesame Seeds

1 tsp Coleman dry mustard

2 tsp salt

1/2 tsp fresh garlic, crushed

1/2 tsp black pepper

Mix lettuces, green onion and tomato in a large bowl. Garnish with wonton pi and sesame seeds. Mix dressing ingredients in a jar and chill.

Pour dressing over salad just before serving.
