

1 cup Bisquick Pancake & Baking Mix 1/2 tbsp sugar 1 tsp baking powder

1 tbsp lemon juice 1 large or extra large egg 1 tbsp vegetable oil

1 ea (6 oz) container Yoplait yogurt (any flavor)

Put griddle or fry pan on stove, turn heat on medium heat (level 4-5 on dial) and allow pan to heat up, begin preparing pancake mixture.

Place all ingredients in medium mixing bowl and stir until blended with wire whip. Use spatula to scrape out all yogurt from container. After blending together, batter will look thick, but it is light to feel. Do not add additional water or milk to thin out. Add some butter/margarine to cooking surface and let melt and spread over area pancakes will be cooked on. Use large spoon to get batter and use spatula to spread on cooking surface to make approximate 3" pancake. Let cook till slightly crispy brown, then turn to cook other side until done. Makes 6 pancakes. Serve with your favorite syrup. (Optional Note: I added 1 mashed overripe banana and miniature chocolate chips to batter too.)

Note: I didn't have any milk, so decided to try using the banana yogurt I had on hand. Could probably use other brand yogurts. I haven't tried that yet, but plan too.
