



## Green Beans with Miso Sauce (from Hawaii's Best Salads, Sides and Soups by Jean Watanabe Hee)

1 lb green beans

### Sauce:

1/3 cup mayonnaise

2 1/2 tablespoons miso

1/2 tablespoon sugar, adjust to taste

1 1/2 tablespoons toasted sesame seeds

Cut green beans into 1 1/2 inch pieces and parboil until tender (about 5 to 10 minutes). Drain and cool. Combine sauce ingredients. Mix beans into sauce. Chill for 1 hour.

**Note:** When the green beans are tender, this dish is a favorite!

**Yield:** 6 servings.
