

1/2 lb char siu, chopped 1 stalk green onions, chopped 1 tbsp shoyu 1/2 tsp granulated sugar 1 tbsp cornstarch, dissolved in 2 tbsp water 1-2 cans refrigerator buttermilk biscuits

Heat 1 thsp oil in skillet, then stir fry char siu and onions. Add shoyu and sugar. Add cornstarch mixture, stirring constantly until mixture thickens. Cool to room temperature. Flatten the biscuits and fill with a spoonful of filling. Pinch biscuit to close. Put pinched side downon a lightly greased cookie sheet, and bake as directed on biscuit package. Bake 450 degrees 10 minutes.
