Imitation Chinese Bird Nest Soup (fm 50th Anniversary Best of our Favorite Recipes 1946-1998 Island of Maui)



1 bundle long rice (bean thread)

1 1/2 tsp salt

5 cups chicken broth (low sodium)

2 eggs, well beaten

1/2 cup pork hash

1/2 cup boiled ham

1 cup bamboo shoots

1/2 cup mushrooms

1/2 cup green onions

Soak long rice in boiling water for 1/2 to 1 hour. Drain and cut into very small pieces. Saute pork hash till cooked, breaking up into small pieces. Chop ham, bamboo shoots, mushrooms, green onions into small pieces. Add all ingredients except eggs and green onion to stock and simmer for 15-20 minutes.

Just before serving, continually stir soup and pour in the beaten eggs slowly. Add green onions.

Yeild: 6-8 (3/4 cup) servings.
