

3/4 lb char siu 1 tsp sesame oil 1/4 cup chopped green onion 2 1/2 tbsp sugar

4 tbsp soy sauce

1 pkg frozen bread dough
1 tbsp Lum Yee Kee's char siu sauce
2 tsp flour
2 tsp cornstarch
1/4 cup water

FILLING: Dice char siu into small pieces. In a saucepan or wok, heat oil and stir-fry char siu. Add green onions, sugar and soy sauce. Mix flour and cornstarch with water. Stir into char siu. Cook until mixture thickens; cool.

CHAR SIU BAO: Cut up bread dough that has been thawed to individual portions and flatten. Put about 1 tablespoon char siu filling in the center of the dough. Form buns by pulling dough up and around filling. Pinch to seal seams. Place on baking sheet lined with parchment paper or silicon pad, sealed side down. Let the char siu bao rest for 30 to 45 minutes to rise a little. Bake at 350 degrees for about 10 - 15 minutes, or until browned on the outside.

Dr. Koon-Hui Wang, Associate Professor and Chair, Dept. of Plant and Environmental Protection Sciences (PEPS), at the University of Hawaii Manoa will speak on "Pest Management for Hobby Orchid Gardeners" with a focus on insectary plants. What are insectary plants? you ask. Well insectary plants are those that attract insects to control thrips, spider mites, and other orchid pests through biological pest control rather than insecticides. Insectary plants increase the abundance and effectiveness of natural enemies that help suppress pest populations.

Dr. Wang received a PhD in Plant Pathology, an M.S. in Horticulture and a B.S. in Horticulture. She is a noted authority in her field, has published numerous articles and books, teaches at UH Manoa and conducts research.
