

Spicy Soy-glazed Edamame Pods (fm HMSA Island Scenes Spring 2019)

1 tbsp chili paste 1 tbsp white miso

1/2 tsp sesame oil 2 tsp vegetable oil

1 tbsp reduced-sodium shoyu

2 garlic cloves, minced

1 lb package frozen edamame in pods, thawed

In a small bowl, whisk together chili paste, miso, shoyu, and sesame oil. Set aside. Heat vegetable oil in a skillet over medium heat and saute garlic about 1 minute. Reduce heat and add sauce and edamame. Toss to combine, stirring constantly until heated through.
