

Macaroni (Ziti) and Cheese (from Hawaii's Best Local Dishes by Jean Watanabe Hee)

1 pkg ziti or elbow macaroni (16 oz) 1 pkg cubed cheddar cheese (24 oz)

Sauce:

1 can evaporated milk, (12 oz)
1 cup water
2 cups sour cream
1 container cottage cheese (8 oz)
1/2 cup butter, melted
1/2 cup flour

Cook ziti according to package directions. Mix sauce ingredients, blending butter and flour last. In a large roasting pan, layer ziti on bottom, cubed cheese next and then sauce on top.

Bake at 350 degrees F., uncovered, for 1 hour.

(Note: For cheese lovers! This is a hearty and rich baked macaroni and cheese.
