TAPIOCA PEARL JEWELED DESSERT (from the Kitchen of Mae Matsumoto)

7 cups water

1 1/2 cups sugar

Additional & Optional Ingredients:

2(3 oz) boxes strawberry Jello gelatin (or any flavor)

4 packets Knox gelatin

2 pkgs of coconut gel (Jubes or Monika)

1-2 cans Mandarin oranges, drained

1 can Lychee, drained

1 cup small tapioca pearls (Cock's brand)

1 12 oz Hawaiian Sun coconut milk

3 cups boiling water

1 cup tap water (to dissolve plain gelatin)

18 oz carton whipping cream (do not whip)

1 (20 oz) can pineapple chunks, drained

1 cup frozen blueberries or strawberries

<u>Prepare jello jigglers</u>: Dissolve plain gelatin in 1 cup water. Put strawberry gelatin in large bowl and dissolve with boiling water. Add plain gelatin to hot strawberry gelatin mixture and mix until combined and dissolved. Spray 9 x 13 pan lightly with cooking spray. Pour strawberry gelatin mixture into pan. Pop any bubbles. Refrigerate till set. Cut into small 1/2 inch squares.

<u>Prepare tapioca</u>: Boil water in medium size pot. Add tapioca pearls and continue to boil, stirring constantly for at least 15 minutes. Turn off heat, add sugar and stir to dissolve sugar; cover and let cool. When cooled down to room temperature, add coconut milk; refrigerate.

Drain canned fruits and add to serving container with coconut gels, frozen blueberries or strawberries, whipping cream, prepared strawberry gelatin and tapioca. Stir gently to combine. Refrigerate till ready to serve.

Note: If using large tapioca pearls, cook 5 to 10 minutes longer (Reese's brand). Along with the tapioca, mostof the optional ingredients can be found at Liliha or Kam Times or Liliha Foodland Supermarkets - Oriental section.
