INGREDIENTS

1 block cream cheese, softened 1/2 cup mayonnaise 1 tbsp Worcestershire sauce

1 can (6 oz) ajitsuke clams, partially drained 1/2 bottle kim chee, chopped coarsely 2 tbsp kim chee juice

PREPARATION:

An hour or so before you're going to make the dip, set the cream cheese out to soften.

Mix together the softened cream cheese, mayonnaise, and Worcehtershire sauce. Add the clams and some of their juice, then the kim chee and the kim chee juice. Mix well.

Serve with crudites or your favorite potato chips.
