PULLED PORK W/GUAVA BARBECUE SAUCE (from Hurry Up & Wait Star Advertiser by Betty Shimabukuro & Joleen Oshiro)

The wonders of guava jelly extend for beyond the canvas of a piece of toast, as this recipe will attest. Its presence in a homemade barbecue sauce lends the necessary sweetness to balance the acidity of vinegar and spiciness of Dijon mustard. Add in some other staples of the pantry and you've got a lively sauce that also works well with pork ribs.

1 cup water
Sauce:
1 1/2 tbsp dried minced onions
1/4 cup water
1/2 cup ketchup
1/4 cup guava jelly
2 tbsp Dijon mustard

4-5 pound pork butt roast

2 tbsp Worchestershire sauce2 tsp vinegar1 tbsp soy sauce2 tsp salt

1/2 tsp garlic powder

Chili pepper flakes, to taste (optional)

Place water and pork in pressure cooker pot. Seal lid, bring to pressure on high, lower heat, and cook 1 hour. Allow natural pressure release, then check for doneness. Meat should fall apart easily when shredded with a fork. If necessary, cook under pressure another 10 to 15 minutes. When done, drain pork and shred with two forks.

While pork is cooking, mix dried onions with water, and let sit for 10 minutes to hydrate.

In bowl, combine rest of ingredients, whisking together if necessary to incorporate guava jelly. Add onions, Set aside.

When pork is shredded, pour sauce over meat, and mix. Serve on buns with lettuce, tomato & sliced fresh onions, in tortilla wrap, or as pizza topping.
