INGREDIENTS

1 lb roast pork

2 bunches watercress (2 lbs)

1 small round onion or 1/2 medium onion

1/4 cup shoyu 1-2 tbsp sugar

PREPARATION:

Cut roast pork into bite size pieces and brown. Chop onion and add to pork. Rinse and chop watercress and add to pork.

Mix sugar and shoyu. Add and cook with pork, onion and watercress for 5-10 minutes. Turn off stove and let sit for another 5-10 minutes.
